CODE OF CONDUCT

RESPECT THE GAME

- Play the game with fairness and good spirit
- Do not abuse, swear at, or direct derogatory remarks of any kind toward any umpire, official, volunteer, opposition player or spectator

RESPECT THE CLUB

- Avoid any actions which may result in bringing the Club's name into disrepute

RESPECT YOUR TEAM

- Support your team mates
- Celebrate each other's successes
- Be there to back up your team mates when things aren't going so well
- Turn up on time, and give it your best effort
- Be willing to make sacrifices for others in the team when required

RESPECT YOUR CAPTAIN

- Communicate your game availability with the captain in a timely manner
- You may not always agree with your captain's decisions, but understand that decisions are made with the team's overall interests in mind

RESPECT YOURSELF

- If you witness or experience something that you feel isn't right, speak up
- Call out bad behavior when you see it, either within the Club or outside of it
- MVCC committee members are always keen to hear feedback from players and supporters, positive or negative, and will endeavour to respond appropriately and make suitable improvements when necessary
